Project overview

- Horizon 2020 research project (Coronavirus Global Response Initiative, May 2020)
- 10M Euros / 32 partners / November 2020-October 2023
- Overarching goals:
 1. To map and analyse the impacts of the COVID-19 outbreak
 2. Develop solutions and guidance for policymakers and health authorities on how to mitigate the impact of the outbreak
 3. Enhance Europe's preparedness for future similar events
 4. Reflect on the future multi-level governance in the health as well as other domains affected by the outbreak



WP2 Mental Health and Health Inequalities

- Map, assess and compare (short-&long-term) impacts of COVID-19 and policy measures on mental health and health inequalities
- This desk research will be integrated with data on the socioeconomic impacts (WP1) and impacts on health systems (WP3) in a **COVID Data Atlas** (WP4)
- 1 November 2020- 31 October 2023
- Methodology:
 - Literature review
 - Identification of data, gaps, and inconsistencies
 - Guidance from a multi-disciplinary scientific committee
